Craig and Heather Gahagen have spent 35 years serving Peru through aviation ministry with SAMAIR (South America

Mission), the only missionary aviation provider in the country. Through their work, the Gahagens make it possible for organizations to bring the Gospel to over 55 different tribes across an area the size of California.

In addition to being a pilot, Craig serves as the regional director for South America Mission and manages the aviation operations. Heather oversees finances to ensure smooth operations. Together, they lead a dedicated team of eight aviation and office personnel, committed to advancing God's work in Peru.

Men's Retreat March 28-29, 2025


Join us at Hall's Bayou Ranch in Santa Fe for our annual men's retreat! For those wishing to spend the night, you
