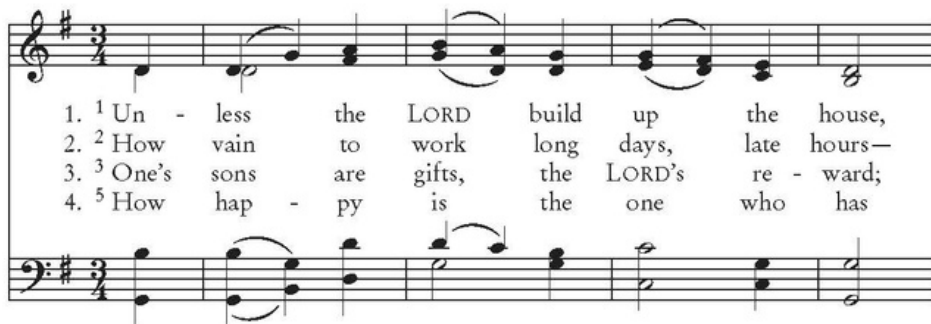

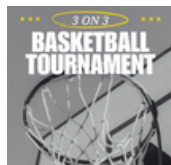
Grace of God Senior Ministry **Today, 1:30-3pm**
